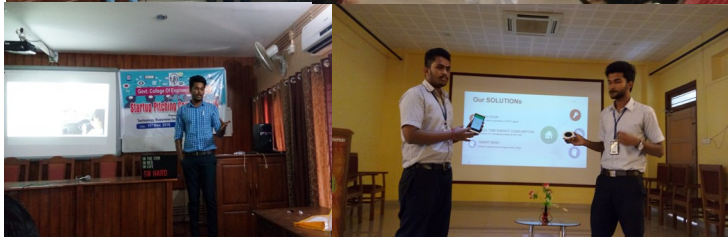

Now, VJEC is empanelled in Udyamita Scheme by the government of India.
